

PASSION FOR TECHNOLOGY

It is often claimed that technological innovations result in job losses, but historical trends suggest otherwise. For instance, when computerization began in the banking industry around 1989-90, replacing record-keeping roles, there was widespread resistance. Many feared that clerical jobs would be eliminated, leading to protests across India. However, in hindsight, this shift actually generated more employment opportunities.

Similarly, around the year 2000, numerous manufacturing industries adopted ERP systems, particularly SAP, despite challenges such as poor IT infrastructure and connectivity issues. Employees voiced concerns about job security and encountered difficulties in adapting to the new technologies. Yet, over time, these advancements led to increased efficiency and created new job roles. Large corporations like TATA, Mahindra, and Bajaj had started working with ERP to streamline their business processes. Employees in these companies started resisting, saying it would eat up their jobs. They were having connectivity issues as data transfer speeds used to be in kbps (kilobytes per second). It used to take a longer time for data transmission between different branches of the same organization. Also, server technology was just evolving, so frequent server breakdowns were a major problem. People were not comfortable adapting and working on the ERP and other allied technologies.

The emergence of social media and cryptocurrencies like Bitcoin circa 2010 further transformed the job market, facilitating global connectivity and lowering data rates. Despite

initial apprehensions, these developments opened up new avenues for employment.

More recently, the advent of Artificial Intelligence and Robotics has sparked fears of job displacement, particularly in repetitive and risky tasks. However, these technologies have also created opportunities for roles requiring specialized skills.

Presently, there is anxiety regarding the impact of generative AI, such as ChatGPT and Bard, on both creative and repetitive job sectors. Yet, history suggests that while certain technologies may lead to job losses, they also pave the way for new opportunities in related fields. It is essential for individuals to adapt and upskill themselves on various technological platforms to remain competitive in the evolving job market. Opportunities abound in areas like Data Science, Internet of Things (IoT), Cloud Computing, Cyber Security, and Business Intelligence etc.

Therefore, embracing new technologies and continuously enhancing ones skills is crucial for navigating the changing job landscape.

AMUL INDUSTRIAL VISIT

This visit provided valuable insights into the production processes, quality control measures, and the overall functioning of the Amul factory.

The visit began with an informative presentation about the history of Amul, its cooperative model, and its significant contribution to India's dairy sector. It started at the milk reception area, where raw milk from local farmers is collected and tested for quality. The emphasis on quality is evident from the rigorous testing procedures in place. We were taken through various processing units where milk undergoes pasteurisation, homogenization, and separation. The automated machinery ensures precision and efficiency in these processes. The factory produces a wide range of dairy products, including milk powder, butter, ghee, cheese, and ice cream. Each product has dedicated manufacturing units with stringent quality control measures. The packaging unit showcased advanced packaging technology to ensure product freshness and safety. 
