Bharat Manjunath: Currently a Consulting Manager at Cognizant (UK), Bharat provided a sophisticated look into the European consulting landscape. He shared his journey of adapting to international work cultures and managing complex, cross-border technology projects.

Anirban Biswas: Serving as Director of Research at Sutherland (UK), Anirban offered deep strategic insights into the global research industry. He discussed how data-driven intelligence is utilized at the highest levels of decision-making in international markets.



Session Highlights & Impact

The dialogue, moderated by Dr. Saisree Mangu, focused on the "Global Professional"—what it takes for an IBS graduate to excel on the world stage.

Student Reception: Participating from their various internship locations across India, students were highly motivated by the international trajectory of the panelists. The Q&A session was particularly focused on the skills required to transition into global roles and the nuances of the UK corporate environment.

Alumni Reflections: Despite the time zone difference, both Bharat and Anirban were eager to share their "East to West" career journeys. They highlighted that the foundational rigors of the IBS curriculum prepared them well for the challenges of the global market.

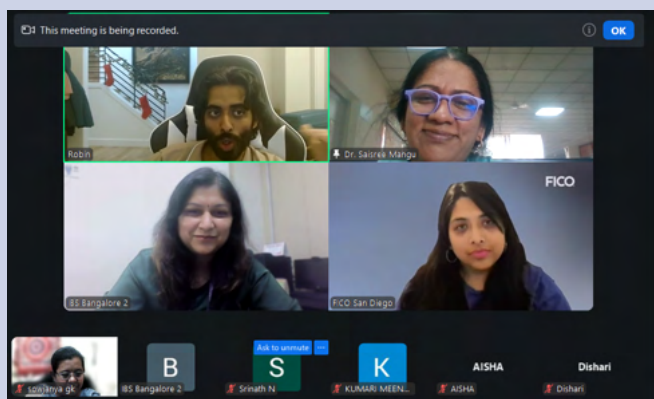
ConnectX #4

Deboleena Roy: Serving as Talent Acquisition Lead at FICO (North America), Deboleena offered a unique dual perspective on global recruitment and human capital. Her insights into what top-tier firms look for in international candidates were particularly timely for our students currently in the midst of their own internships.
